

Guidelines for contributors

Original contributions in the form of **Full Papers**, not exceeding 10 typed pages including illustrations and tables and Short Communications, not exceeding 3 typed pages including illustrations and tables in the different aspects of **Life Sciences, Agriculture and Plant Nematology** will be considered for publication in **Bioved, New Agriculturist and Current Nematology** respectively. Critical mini-reviews on current topics and book reviews will also be published. Two copies of manuscript type/written clearly and concisely in English in double space on good quality paper with at least 4 cm margin on left side, should be sent to **Dr. Brijesh K. Dwivedi, General Secretary, Bioved Research Society, 252A/4A, Om Gayatri Nagar, Teliarganj, Allahabad-211 004, U.P., India or 103/42, M.L.N. Road, Allahabad-211 002, U.P., India.**

The first page of manuscript should contain the title (in capital letters) : names of the author(s) and address of the laboratory/place where the work was conducted ; a running title not exceeding five words and address for correspondence. Title should be repeated on the next page but without names and address of author (s). Title should be short and specific to identify the content of the article.

An **Abstract**, not exceeding 300 words, which should contain no references along with three to six **Keywords** must be provided below the abstract. **Introduction** should be brief, to the point and may contain pertinent review of literature. **Materials and Methods** should contain description of the study site (if required), materials used and experimental techniques followed.

If the methods are well known, only reference should be given. **Results** should not be repeated in **Discussion**. To avoid this, these sections may preferably be combined and should be followed by **Acknowledgment**, if any.

Illustrations and tables should be kept to the bare minimum (since these are expensive to print) and numbered consecutively in arabic numerals (e.g. fig. 1 etc.). Authors will be charged for photographic plates. Drawings should be made in black ink on good quality tracing paper or drawing. Xerox copies of all figures and plates should also be provided for sending to the reviewers. Figures and plates should not be larger than 13 x 18 cm or 26 x 36 cm. The illustration should be arranged as to allow half size reduction. Photographs for plates must be of high quality and printed on glazed paper. A separate type written (in double space) **Explanation of figures and plates** should be listed. The data presented in tables should not be repeated in figures.

Citation of **reference in the text** should be as Dwivedi and Mishra (1988) or (Dwivedi and Mishra, 1988) depending upon the construction of the sentence. In case of papers by more than two authors, *et al.*, should be used with the name of first author.

In the list, References should be arranged alphabetically without serial numbers and follow the following models-

PAPERS : Zirakparvar, M.E., Norton, D.C. and Cox, C.P. 1980. Population increase of *Pratylenchus hexincisis* on corn as related to soil temperature and type. *J. Nematol.*, **12** : 313-318.

BOOK : Dwivedi, Brijesh K. and Mishra, S.D., 1989. Survey of Researches in Plant Nematology. Vol. I B. R.S. Publication, Allahabad, 377 pages.

PART OF BOOK : Dwivedi, Brijesh K., 1989. Non-chemical approaches to plant nematodes diseases control *In : Recent trends in Toxicology* (Ed. R.P. Agarwal), 20-37 pp.

THESIS : Mishra, S.D., 1972. Effect of organic matter and inorganic fertilizers on soil and plant nematodes. Ph.D. thesis 300 pp, Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi.

All authors Should be member of the journal Accepted paper will be published in free of cost in the journal. It is presumed that the papers submitted to **Bioved, New Agriculturist and Current Nematology** are not being simultaneously or have not been previously submitted to any other journal. The papers are published on the advice of referees. The publishers and Editors assume no responsibility for the views and statements of authors in their papers. As a part of publication policy, the first and second author of every accepted paper must subscribe to the journal. If the manuscript conforms to the above instructions, the paper is likely to be published within 6 months of the date of receipt.
