

Clinical management of juvenile cellulitis in puppies –A report

ABSTRACT : A one month old Great Dane male pup, one month old Great Dane Female pup, 5 weeks old Labrador male pup and two one month old Labrador female pups were presented with the history of alopecia, erythema, scale, crust, swelling in the ventral neck region, as well as nodular and pustular skin lesions. Red spots and pustules present in the lower abdomen, lower and upper lips and they were lethargic but still had normal appetite. The pups were examined individually, relevant samples were collected and treated accordingly.
